How did the Fund perform in the last year?

For the fiscal year ended September 30, 2024, the Institutional Share Class of the Fund returned 39.62%. The Fund's primary benchmark, the Russell 1000 Growth Index (TR), returned 42.19%. In addition, the Fund's regulatory benchmark, the S&P 500 Index (TR), returned 36.35%.


Investment results for the fiscal year were not uniform across quarters. The Institutional Class Shares gained 19.74% for the December quarter, 9.20% for the March quarter, 2.94% for the June quarter, and 3.73% in the September quarter.

The Fund's investment results were not uniform across sectors. The Fund's best performing sectors during the period were Information Technology, Communication Services and Financials. The Fund's worst performing sectors were Real Estate and Consumer Staples. The Fund's best performing individual positions were NVIDIA Corp, Meta Platforms, Netflix Inc, Uber Technologies Inc, and Microsoft Corp. The Fund's worst performers were Five9 Inc, Luluemon Athletica Inc, Illumina Inc, Nike Inc and Applied Materials Inc.

The RiverPark Large Growth Fund seeks to make investments in securities of large capitalization companies, which it defines as those in excess of \$5 billion. The Fund invests in what it believes are exciting growth businesses with significant long-term growth potential, but patiently waits for opportunities to purchase these companies at attractive prices. RiverPark believes the style is best described as a "value orientation toward growth." RiverPark believes that the current market environment provides it with an opportunity to own a diversified portfolio of growth stocks at attractive valuations.



Householding

Rule 30e-1 of the Investment Company Act of 1940 permits funds to transmit only one copy of a proxy statement, annual report or semi-annual report to shareholders (who need not be related) with the same residential, commercial or electronic address, provided that the shareholders have consented in writing and the reports are addressed either to each shareholder individually or to the shareholders as a group. This process is known as “householding” and is designed to reduce the duplicate copies of materials that shareholders receive and to lower printing and mailing costs for funds.
